

- SCUBAPRO® SmartTRAK 2.09


The described workaround works only for older Dive Computers, for eg. the SCUBAPRO® ALADIN [2] / Aladin Square...



LogTRAK 1.5.0.7 allows only for TravelTRAK Format (*.asd) :


